Dear Ms. Wheaton:

Pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Title 49, Part 23 and 26, and the Airport's DBE Program Plan, certification must be reviewed annually by submitting a "No Change in Eligibility Affidavit". The Aviation Department at Charlotte/Douglas International Airport is in receipt of your affidavit" and has re-affirmed your status for **DBE certification which expires June 15, 2005.**

The Aviation Department will notify you at the appropriate time to submit a new disclosure affidavit or re-certification form. Should there be a change in ownership, control, address and telephone number during the certification period, you must promptly notify the Aviation Department. Failure to do so may jeopardize your current and future eligibility as a DBE Firm.
